1964: Three campus mothers unable to find a pre-primary school for their little ones decided to start one themselves with the blessings of the Vice- Chancellor and the approval of the Director, Gandhi Bhawan to use their premises. The philosophy behind was simple: playing and learning in a joyful, loving and beautiful environment. In the first years the mothers taught and learned themselves, but once the number of children increased, teachers had to be engaged and the school's management had to be formalized and structured. Campus School Society was born and registered in 1967 with a representative membership of all categories of staff members of the University and its affiliated colleges, who during all these years, have been giving freely and voluntarily of their time and expertise for the benefit of the school. The Constitution of the society reflects its objective, scope, rules and regulations. The curriculum also



integrates the development of an understanding of democratic and egalitarian values and citizen's responsibilities and to give special facilities and support to children of economically and socially disadvantaged parents, as well as to children with special needs.

The great advantage of the school is of course its location on the University campus, where it benefits from the interaction of high level academicians in fields related to education. A special mention may be made of the University Department of Human Development, which uses the school as its laboratory for M.Sc. students.

Campus Nursery School itself has developed its theme based curriculum on Active Learning lines. This curriculum and its implementation took several years of deliberation, consideration and implementation, at one stage with the expertise and involvement of Ryerson's College, Toronto.



Why Choose Campus Nursery School

Campus Nursery School provides an environment to let children grow in a free and creative atmosphere, through planned activities that help to keep a balanced mental, intellectual, moral and physical growth of the child.

The school is way ahead from others as it provides an emotionally secure and supportive environment conducive for a child to realize his or her potentials. Realising the importance of each stage in a child's development, we move with care and caution from informal to formal learning. Over the years, we have learnt how emphasis on a child's overall development helps him/her cope better with structured learning in later years.

The school makes special efforts to gain trust and confidence of the child. It helps to inculcate the habit of observing and asking questions by igniting his/her curiosity. It instils in them values of loving, caring and sharing. It also creates an ambience in which they can express themselves freely. Gradual progression from informal to formal; unstructured to structured; reading to writing enables the child to make learning a joyful and gainful experience.

It is wonderful that our alumni have made a mark at every stage of life-school, college, career and life in general for more than 60 years.

















Building and Infrastructure

The building and infrastructure of a school is considered as a key element in child's growth and holistic development. The 6000 sq. ft. of area is developed for the physical and mental activities. Jungle gym, splash pool, sand pit, lush green garden with safe swings and slides are some of the amenities and facilities where children are close to nature and develop their physical and creative skills.

The classrooms are spacious and well ventilated. The school has a large activity hall for audio visual activities like introducing value based stories, visual learning, themes and concepts, a non-fire cooking lab and cognitive activity room. Separate washrooms for boys and girls equipped with age-appropriate fittings are there. The school library has a huge collection of books covering a range of interesting topics for preschoolers and their parents. The school building is surrounded by a huge open space for free outdoor play with a variety of slides and swings.









The Thought Process / Curriculum

It has been scientifically proven that in the first five to six years, development is fastest than in any other period of life. It is at this stage that basic traits of character and personality are formed. Our curriculum ensures a balanced mental and physical growth. Great care is taken in planning activities that will equip young children with social skills and moral values.

We are constantly aware that children have different needs, interests and abilities. While we may list common characteristics of each age group, each individual develops cognitive and social skills in different ways at his or her own pace. We emphasize a child's overall development, which is achieved not through rote learning, but joyful exploration and appreciation of the environment.

Active learning and thematic approach are the basis of our teaching strategy.







Age: Completed 3 years but less than 4 years as on July 31, 2025.

Emphasis: Development of Language and Pre-Writing Skills

Introduction to 3R'S

Reading, Writing, Arithmetic are subtly introduced.

Readiness to Read: Language is introduced as different sounds, helping to distinguish those sounds and to relate them to the names of the objects in their environment, this is how they learn A,B,C.....

Readiness to Write: It is the first time a child holds a thick soft colour to write or scribble. We take complete care that all the tasks of motor development are done at the right age of the child (Pediatric Recommendations). No forceful writing or activity is expected from the child, which may lead to deformations of the fingers. Pre-writing skills, beading, paper tearing, rolling, clay modelling, cutting & pasting are some of the activities which precede writing by developing finger dexterity. Learning to understand, use and enjoy language is the first step that forms the foundation of learning. This level aims towards readiness of basic skills of reading, writing and arithmetic.

Readiness to Arithmetical Skills: We endeavour to provide learning through observation and practical tasks related to the child's daily environment. Children learn to understand numbers after pre-arithmetic skills like concepts of big and small, few and many etc. Recognising, visualising and associating quantity helps in meaningful understanding of numbers.
